



# Snowflake Ornament

Thank you for taking the time to make our snowflake ornament pattern! This little ornament is perfect for winter decorating, adding a special touch to a gift, or hanging on the Christmas tree! We hope you enjoy it for years to come :)

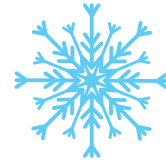
This includes instructions for a crocheted snowflake, using Bernat Softee Chunky yarn, a super bulky size 6, and a 6mm (J-10) crochet hook. One small ball (approx. 108 yds) makes about 9 snowflakes. Since about 12 yds of Bernat Softee Chunky yarn makes one snowflake, this is an amazing stash buster for all of those scraps! As seen in the picture above, you can stagger two and glue them together to make a two-tone ornament.

This pattern doesn't require a specific type of yarn, so feel free to adjust your hook size and use any yarn.

This project is perfect for beginners, and is worked up in double crochet, single crochet, slip stitches, and chains.

## MATERIALS

- US J-10 (6mm) hook
- 1 small skein of Bernat Softee Chunky yarn (makes approx 9 snowflakes) or approx. 12 yds (11m) of Bernat Softee Chunky yarn to make one snowflake
- yarn needle
- scissors



## LEGEND

- ch - chain
- st - stitch
- sts - stitches
- sl st - slip stitch
- sc - single crochet
- dc - double crochet
- dcs - double crochets
- sk - skip

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Note - All pictures are taken by Dianne, who is left handed, so pictures might be in the opposite direction for you. If you're left handed, you're in luck because this will be one of very few patterns you don't have to imagine backwards!

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). Dc 11 in first ch. Sl st between first and second dc to join the circle (12 dc, and 12 dc spaces). (See **IMAGE A** for finished row)

Row 2: \*Ch 3, continue in the same direction, do not turn. Sc in next 2 dc spaces. Repeat from \* 5 more times, do not join (6 ch3 spaces and 12 sc). (See **IMAGE B** for finished row)

Row 3: Continue in the same direction, do not turn. \*(sc 3, ch 5, sc 3) in next ch3 spot. Sk 1 sc from row 2, sc 1 into the space between **2 dcs from row 1** (directly below the second sc from row 2). (See **IMAGE C** for where to complete this st) Repeat from \* 5 more times. Sl st in first sc in row 3 to fasten off. Weave in end(s). (See **IMAGE D** for finished snowflake)
